
Demand Side Grid Support Program

FranklinWH customers may enroll in the California Demand Side Grid Support (DSGS) Program through the FranklinWH App. This is a Virtual Power Plant (VPP) program that provides you incentives for supplying your stored energy to the grid at critical times.

The enrollment steps are described below.

 Log into the FranklinWH App with your homeowner account. Tap Enroll Now on the pop-up window, or on your energy home screen, tap Settings > Virtual Power Plant (VPP) to begin enrollment.





You need to review and then select the button to agree to the **Terms & Conditions**.


Then tap **Complete** to submit the application.



4. You will receive a notification once the application has been successfully submitted.


"Thank you for applying to the Demand Side Grid Support Program. You will receive an email or message in-app with your application status within the next 2 weeks."

The page will remain **Application in review** until the review is completed.






A notification will be sent once the utility has reviewed the application.




The **Enrollment information** status will change to **Accepted** or **Rejected**, depending on the result.

 24 hours prior to an event, you will receive a notification informing you of event times and power to be supplied to the grid.

Example:
