


Smart Battery Pilot Program Enrollment Guidance

FranklinWH customers may enroll in the PGE Smart Battery Pilot Program through the FranklinWH App.

Prerequisites

The installer or homeowner selects **Portland General Electric Co** as the Utility Company on the **Tariff Settings** page.




The **Virtual Power Plant** option (Step 2, next page) will appear in the menu bar on your energy **Settings** screen.

Note: Once you return to the **Settings** screen, you need to manually scroll down to refresh it. Then you will be able to access the **Virtual Power Plant** option in the menu.

Procedure


The device registration steps are described below.

1. Log into the FranklinWH App on the homeowner account.
2. On your energy home screen, tap **Settings** > **Virtual Power Plant (VPP)** to begin enrollment.




3. Tap **Get a Pairing Code** to go to the Smart Battery Pilot registration page. After completing registration and passing the review, you will receive a Pairing Code.

You may then enter the Pairing Code and select the aGate to enroll.



- The Pairing Code will be shown on the page when the aGate has been successfully enrolled. You may add the aGate or remove the enrolled aGate from the list.



- Prior to a grid event (import, export or standby), you will receive a notification informing you of event times and power.

Example:

“Join the [Program Name] export period from [Date][Time] to [Time], power xx kW.

Participate in event set to Active.”

Tap a registered aGate on the **Program details** page (shown in the previous step) to enter **Events list** page. Select the specific event to check the event details.

NOTE: Participation in the event is enabled by default.
