

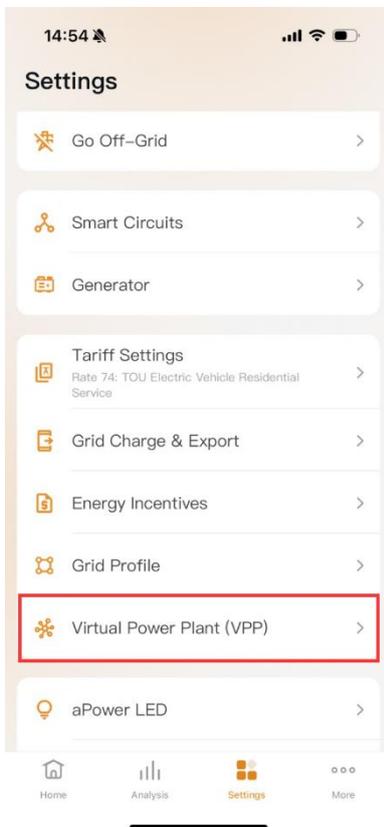
Solar Battery Savings Program Enrollment Guidance

FranklinWH customers may enroll in the San Diego Community Power Solar Battery Savings Program through the FranklinWH App.

Procedure

The device registration steps are described below.

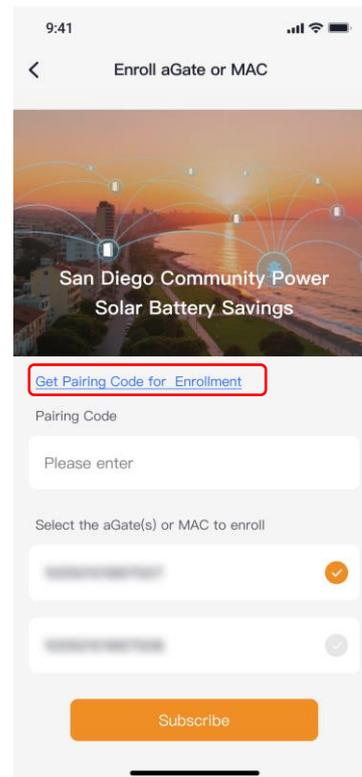
1. Login to the FranklinWH App with your homeowner account.
2. On your energy home screen, tap **Settings > Virtual Power Plant (VPP)** to begin enrollment.



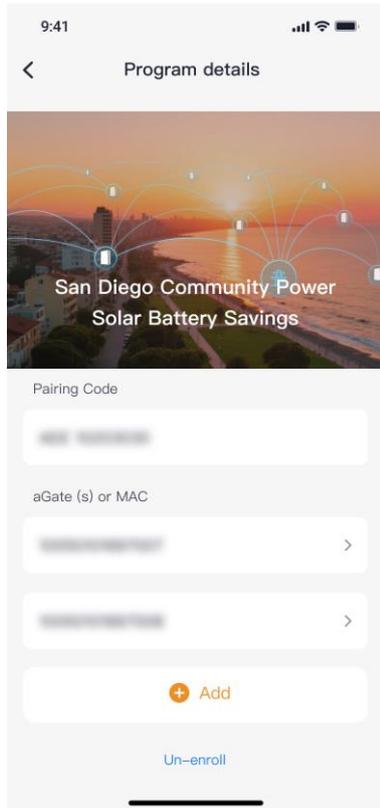
3. Tap **Get Pairing Code for Enrollment** to go to the San Diego Community Power Solar Battery Savings registration page.

Note: Once your registration is complete, you'll receive a unique Pairing Code for your FranklinWH System, required for program enrollment. Store this code in a safe place, as you'll need it when entering it in the FranklinWH App.

4. You may then enter the Pairing Code for all aGates/MACs to be enrolled on site.



5. The Pairing Code will be shown on the page when an aGate/MAC has been successfully enrolled.
- You may add each aGate/MAC from the list. To leave the program, tap **Un-enroll** in the bottom.



6. Prior to a grid event (import, export or standby), you will receive a notification informing you of the event timing and the power to be supplied to the grid.

Example:

“Join the [Program Name] export period from [Date][Time] to [Time], power xx kW.

Participate in event set to Active.”

Tap a registered aGate/MAC on the **Program details** page (shown in the previous step) to enter the **Events list** page. Select the specific event to check the event details.

NOTE: The default action is *opt-in on the event*. You can always choose to *opt-out*.
